**Kataifi** is a special form of shredded

phyllo dough.

A Jewish marriage contract found in the Cairo Geniza dating to around 1010 mentions "... ben Isaac Ha-Levi, known as al-Kataif." Today, Kataifi remains a primarily Jewish surname.

Produced in the Levant region since the Arab invention of the alembic still, **Arak** is a distilled spirit made from grapes and flavored with anise seed. The liquor turns a milky color when water

or ice is added. That and its strength are why it's called "milk of lions" in the Middle East.

One of the seven species listed in the Torah, **dates** play a starring role on the tables of many Jewish holidays. They are a "first fruit" to be eaten on Rosh Hashanah, used in Charoset for Passover and its palm fronds are central to the Sukkot lullav.

**Hawaij** is a spice blend including black pepper, turmeric, baking

spices & cardamom. There is both a savory version as well as one for coffee and desserts.
